The goal of CIU is to provide personal and professional development of the student in accordance with the requirements of the local and international labor market.



CIU Faculty of Medicine has been operating since 1995 and has numerous successful and highly qualified alumni. Each Educational Program envisages basic and clinical disciplines. Modern infrastructure and technical equipment contribute to creating a perfect environment both for professors and students. Practical classes are conducted in leading Georgian clinics and medical institutions, thus facilitating the employment of successful students in the future.

Anatomical Theatre and Clinical Skills Center are functioning at the faculty of Medicine, Caucasus International University. They are equipped with the latest educational-medical technologies – modern computer and high-tech equipment, simulators and other educational models manufactured by the International Corporation "3B Scientific". Clinical Skills Centre aims to develop practical clinical skills to future doctors that meet the international requirements of modern medical education. Students have an opportunity to acquire basic clinical, emergency, obstetrics and gynecological, resuscitation, therapeutic and surgical practical skills. Clinical Skills Centre plays an important role in the upbringing and formation of highly qualified medical personnel.

Within the framework of the **Dentistry Program, Phantom Cabinets and University Dental Clinic** are operating at the university, which enable students to have direct contact with patients from an early stage of studies.









Internationalization represents one of the priorities of the university. Programs offered in English and tailored to modern standards provoke great interest among international students.

CIU is a member of **The World Directory of Medical Schools** (World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) and **Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research** (FAIMER)).

CIU was included in the list of acknowledged foreign Medical Institutions by Medical Council of India (MCI) in 2016.

CIU joined the International Association for Medical Education – "AMEE" in 2018. We are constantly working on the issue of recognition of diploma issues by us with the governments of countries that are not members of the Bologna Process and do not automatically recognize the European education system.

GMC/GDC Approval – CIU Medicine and Dentistry programs fully meet GMC/GDC criteria, which means integrating at least 5500 practical contact hours into the Medicine program and 1600 contact hours into the Dentistry program.

Students have the opportunity to acquire systematic knowledge of viticulture and winemaking, to study and implement classical and innovative methods of winemaking with the complete cycle established nowadays – "From the Ground to the Table". Along with this, the priority is to







teach traditional Georgian Qvevri wine technology.

The partners of the faculty - well-known companies of the wine industry are additionally involved in the successful implementation of practices.

Emphasis is placed on teaching foreign languages at the undergraduate program. The program offers English, French and Spanish as the languages of developed wine-growing countries.

The faculty is distinguished by an ever-growing international partnership network, as well as exchange programs at the universities of Burgos and La Rioja in Spain and internships at wineries.

It is also worth mentioning that the university winery "Ethno Okami", which currently produces five types of high-quality Qvevri wine: Shavkapito, Khashmi Sapheravi, Tavkveri, Chinese-Goruli Green and Rkatsiteli and the students of the faculty of Viticulture and Winemaking are actively engaged in wine production process together with the high-qualified specialists.

CIU Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities is distinguished by high-level modern programs adapted to the demands of the domestic and international market and education focused on the practical component, led by practicing specialists.

In the Undergraduate Program of International Relations, a student has the opportunity from the very first year to get involved in technical university research centers and to pay professional visits to state or private structures highlighting foreign policy.

After completing the undergraduate level, it is possible to pursue studies at postgraduate programs in the direction of international relations, where the emphasis is placed on security studies, and at the scientific level, it is possible to continue studies at the Doctoral Program in Political Science.

The Postgraduate Program in Global Politics and Security Studies offered in English is worth mentioning, which is focused on international relations and a high degree of internationalization. The program was developed with the direct involvement of the specialized structure of the United Nations and the European Union—"International Center for Science and Technology".

As for the direction of journalism, the student of the undergraduate program has the opportunity to develop practical skills in the university multimedia center corresponding to modern standards from the very first year.

After completing the undergraduate level, it is possible to pursue studies on Postgraduate Program in Media Studies and Multimedia Production. As for scientific level, a Doctoral Program in Mass Communication is offered.

The undergraduate, graduate and doctoral programs of the CIU Faculty of Law, along with high-level theoretical studies, are distinguished by their practical component, and each program is tailored to the interests of students to the greatest extent.

One of the keys to the success of the faculty is the academic staff recognized not only in Georgia, but also abroad. Highly qualified and leading practicing lawyers participate in the implementation of educational programs.

In order to implement the practical component the following operate at the faculty:

- Legal Clinic which is implemented in the Tbilisi City Court, penitentiary institutions, the Public Defender's Office, the Expert-Criminal Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the Chamber of Notaries of Georgia and leading legal companies;
- $\bullet \, Internal \, legal \, clinic, which \, includes \, the \, practical \, components \, of \, lawyer \, and \, forensics \, activities;$
- University Moot Courtroom/Tbilisi City Court Sessions Hall Mock trials are held within the framework of all procedural study courses with the participation of students.

Justice Auditorium – The auditorium provides an opportunity for students and other stakeholders to get complete information about the activities of the Ministry of Justice system, its tasks, goals and achievements. In addition, public lectures on various important topics are constantly organized in the educational areas, which will help to introduce the format of public discussion around legal issues and in this way raise public awareness. The main task of the project is to promote student initiatives, popularize public service among young people and attract promising personnel to the Ministry of Justice.

The undergraduate program in law of the Faculty is the first step, where students acquire basic professional theoretical and practical knowledge. At the master's level, students acquire deep and systematic knowledge in the field of private, public or criminal law, while the doctoral program is focused on developing the doctoral student's research skills and becoming a scientist.

Students have the opportunity to use the international library and electronic resources - English-language legal publications, full texts of court decisions and the electronic legal database - "Codex".

Science

A number of mechanisms supporting research activities have been introduced at CIU, including fundamental and small grant competitions for academic staff and young scientists, a co-funding system for grant applications, promotion and financing of participation in international scientific events and publication of scientific papers.

Scientific activities of Caucasus International University are coordinated by the Scientific Research Department, which conducts research grant funding competitions and training of the scientific personnel, identifies opportunities for grant funding and offers the academic staff such services as preparation of grant applications – submission support, technical expertise, provision of field external expertise and others.

"International Journal of Social Sciences" is published at the university, which is a double-blind peer-reviewed journal with open access.

The scientific portal "Research" available on the university website gives the opportunity to strengthen the integration between CIU academic/scientific staff and creates a platform for the creation of new projects, interdisciplinary cooperation, knowledge and experience sharing.

The scientific prize "Tamar" established at CIU, which is awarded every two years for outstanding scientific achievements, can serve as an incentive for scientists working at Caucasus International University.

Caucasus International University library serves the university students, academic staff and other interested individuals.

The library includes a variety of several thousand textbooks (for today, the total number of library books owned by the university is 26,809 items, they correspond to the literature indicated in the syllabi of educational programs), including scientific literature and fiction published in different languages, as well as periodicals and electronic resources.

In order to ensure the high quality of the academic process, **CIU library** constantly updates the book fund, including scientific and educational books, periodicals, electronic databases, multimedia materials and archival collections, which cover a wide range of subjects and disciplines.

The library helps students and professors improve their information literacy skills, access and use information, and provides them with the digital tools and technologies they need for research. In order to achieve this, it possesses important electronic and printed resources, which include empirical experience in the form of books, magazines, electronic databases, articles and bibliographies.

The electronic library of Caucasus International University is available on the following web address – **elibrary.edu.ge**. It represents a bilingual (Georgian, English) electronic Internet resource.

The electronic library is available both within the university internal as well as external network, only to registered users, so it is a very useful resource in the teaching process for both students and professors.

Since 2010, **CIU library** has been collaborating with Georgian Library Consortium, as well as with various university libraries, academic institutions and research centers to expand access to resources and facilitate knowledge sharing. Among them, it is a member of the International Association of University Libraries (**IATUL**).

The independent spaces of **CIU library** are equipped with all the necessary inventory and equipment, have an open access book fund, modern study areas, various spaces for individual and group work, which meet the diverse academic needs of the university community and create a conducive learning environment for studies, research and intellectual engagement.









Lifelong Learning and Career Development Service






Student Mentor


